

REPORT CARD GRADING UPDATE

We have noticed that a number of students in G1 – 9 are missing live classes, without good reason and they are failing to submit work to their teachers on time.

Seven senior staff have spent all day each Thursday, for the last six weeks, contacting students and parents regarding these matters. We have found that in 90% or more of the cases, the student concerned has been misleading their parents and pretending to attend and submit work. This is not acceptable at all.

Therefore, after consulting with the Ministry of Education and taking their advice, students in G4 – 12 who do not fully attend and participate in live classes* or fail to submit* the required work to the teacher, fully completed and on time, now risk losing marks from their report cards for the subject / subjects where problems are found. Starting in WK 14 this system will run for the remainder of the online learning period, while ever the school is closed.

**unless there are CAIE approved extenuating circumstances that are supported by full documentation. Issues with technology, or students failing to save the work in the correct place will not be considered.*
