Dear Parents,

Further to my previous communication in the school Newsletter last week, we have received further clarification today from the Ministry of Education about the requirements for schools working hours during Ramadan. We will now adjust our school day so that all lessons start at 10.00am and the school day ends at 3.00pm, which is more in line with the MOE schools.

We will continue with the existing school timings and schedule today and tomorrow (Monday 12th April) and an updated lesson timings and assessment schedule will follow shortly to accommodate the changed requirements by the MOE. The details of both will be shared by Mr.Mohammad as soon as they are finalized.

We are not going to change the timetable lesson allocations (only the start and end time will change) but will try and place an assessment schedule during the allocated lesson periods rather than after school, which would then take place instead of the lesson. As mentioned this will take place from Tuesday with details to follow. As we are anticipating Ramadan to be called within the next few days I would like to wish all of our families a blessed Ramadan during this Holy month and an early wish of Ramadan Kareem.
