Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD)

Hand, Foot, and Mouth Disease is a mild viral infection common in young children, caused commonly by Coxsackievirus A. This infection is contagious and it spreads through direct contact with an infected person's saliva, fluid from blisters, or contaminated surfaces. The incubation period is typically 3-6 days. Common symptoms to watch for include fever, loss of appetite, sore throat, red spots on the hands and feet, painful blister-like lesions in the mouth.

PREVENTION TIPS



Wash Hands Often with soap and water for 20 seconds



Avoid Touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands



Avoid Close Contact with people who have HFMD



Clean & Disinfect frequently touched surfaces, such as toys

HFMD is usually self-limiting and resolves on its own. There is no specific treatment for hand-foot-and-mouth disease. Frequent hand washing and avoiding close contact with people who have hand-foot-and-mouth disease may help lower your child's risk of infection. Supportive care such as painkillers and hydration are recommended.

It is very important to monitor your child/children before sending them to school for any signs of illness. Our goal is to give our students and your children the best experience here at Nada International School, which includes a healthy safe environment.
