

2024/2025 SYLLABUS DISTRIBUTION

PRE-KG English Term1

Unit 1: Our Bodies

- Focus: Self-awareness and recognizing different parts of the body.
- **Content:** Naming major body parts (head, hands, feet, eyes, nose) and understanding their basic functions.
- Skills: Vocabulary development, self-identification, and following simple instructions.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to name and point to different body parts.
- Activities: Singing songs like "Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes,"
 creating a body outline tracing, and playing "Simon Says."

Unit 2: Colors

- Focus: Color recognition and identification.
- **Content:** Primary colors (red, yellow, blue) and an introduction to secondary colors.
- Skills: Visual discrimination, sorting, and matching.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to identify and name common colors.
- Activities: A "color hunt" in the classroom, sorting colored blocks, and using different colored paints for art projects.

Unit 3: Getting Dressed

- Focus: Learning about clothing and practicing independence.
- **Content:** The names of common clothing items (shirt, pants, socks, shoes, hat).
- Skills: Fine motor skills (e.g., buttoning), vocabulary acquisition, and basic self-help skills.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to name articles of clothing and practice putting on simple items.
- Activities: A dress-up station with various clothes and practicing with button boards.

Unit 4: Shapes

- Focus: Introduction to basic geometric shapes.
- **Content:** 2D shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle).
- **Skills:** Shape recognition, matching, and sorting.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to identify and name basic shapes.
- Activities: Using shape blocks for building, finding shapes in the classroom, and creating pictures with shape cutouts.

Unit 5: Butterflies

- Focus: Observing nature and understanding the life cycle of an insect.
- Content: The transformation of a caterpillar into a butterfly, and related vocabulary.
- Skills: Observation skills, sequencing, and an appreciation for nature.

- **Learning Outcomes:** Children will understand the stages of a butterfly's life cycle.
- Activities: Reading "The Very Hungry Caterpillar," creating butterfly crafts with paper and paint, and observing pictures of real butterflies.

Jolly Phonics Step 1 Group 1

- Focus: Introduction to foundational phonics skills.
- Content: The sounds and actions for the letters s, a, t, i, p, n.
- **Skills:** Sound recognition, blending sounds to form words (e.g., s-a-t), and associating letters with sounds.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to recognize the sounds and actions for the letters in Group 1.
- Activities: Phonics songs with actions, "sound hunts" to find objects starting with those sounds, and practicing letter formation in sand trays.

Math

Unit 1: Fine Motor Skills

- Focus: Developing hand-eye coordination and small muscle control.
- Content: Activities that strengthen hand muscles and refine dexterity.
- Skills: Pencil grip, cutting with safety scissors, and manipulation of small objects.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will improve their control over small movements for future writing and drawing.
- Activities: Sculpting with play-doh, using tweezers to pick up small items, and lacing cards.

Unit 2: Numbers 0 to 5

- Focus: Basic number recognition and counting.
- Content: The numerals 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.
- **Skills:** Rote counting, one-to-one correspondence, and number-to-quantity association.
- **Learning Outcomes:** Children will be able to count up to five and recognize the numerals 0-5.
- Activities: Counting objects (toys, fingers), number puzzles, and singing counting songs etc.

2D Shapes

- Focus: Identification and sorting of basic flat shapes.
- Content: Circles, squares, and triangles.
- **Skills:** Shape recognition, matching, and sorting by shape.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to identify and sort common 2D shapes.

 Activities: Sorting shape blocks, shape matching games, and finding shapes in the environment (e.g., a clock is a circle).

Arts

Fine Motor Skills

- **Focus:** Integrating fine motor development with creative expression.
- Content: Use of art supplies like crayons, paintbrushes, and glue.
- Skills: Grasping tools, controlled movements, and hand strength.
- **Learning Outcomes:** Children will develop the physical coordination required for artistic tasks.
- Activities: Painting with various brush sizes, using jumbo crayons for coloring, and gluing small pieces onto a picture.

Introduction to Colors

- Focus: Experiencing and exploring colors through different media.
- Content: Primary colors and mixing them to create secondary colors.
- **Skills:** Color recognition, artistic experimentation, and creative expression.
- Learning Outcomes: Children will be able to use colors in their artwork and understand how they can be combined.
- Activities: Finger painting with primary colors, using different colored papers for collage, and free-form painting.

Exploring Shapes

- Focus: Using shapes as the foundation for creative projects.
- Content: Creating pictures and designs using basic 2D shapes.

- **Skills:** Spatial reasoning, pattern creation, and imaginative expression.
- **Learning Outcomes:** Children will be able to create compositions using a variety of shapes.
- **Activities:** Cutting out shapes from colored paper to create collages and using shape stamps to make patterns.
